**2. Exodus 3:1-4:20 –page 90 in pew Bibles**

- a. God the Father calls Moses to his assignment.
- b. God does not allow Moses to question his gifts, talents, and calling.
- c. The Promises Land is the focus, not Moses needs, wants, fears and desires".
- d. Signs from the Father to Moses keep him focused and faithful.
- e. The Staff of God keeps Moses confident and faithful.

**3. Session IV-Hezekiah reminds the church that gifts and talents come directly from God for His purpose alone.**

- a. Moses was gifted for his calling by God. God gifts us for our calling. Page 34, 35.
- b. Our destiny is found in saying "yes to our talents" and then stepping out in faith. Page 35, 36, 37.
- c. God can use every gift and talent that we have. Release them!
- d. Having an available spirit is the key.
- e. Deuteronomy 1:26-38 (page 274). Moses prepares Joshua to take God's people into the promise land. Page 38, 39.
