2. **Exodus 3:1-4:20 –page 90 in pew Bibles**
 - a. God the Father calls Moses to his assignment.
 - b. God does not allow Moses to question his gifts, talents, and calling.
 - c. The Promises Land is the focus, not Moses needs, wants, fears and desires”.
 - d. Signs from the Father to Moses keep him focused and faithful.
 - e. The Staff of God keeps Moses confident, faithful and passionate about God’s will for his life and mission.
3. **Jeremiah 17: 5-8 (page 1201) God was not pleased with Judah’s sin and rebellion. He wanted to bless them and make them fruitful.**
